HE has seen his wife for one month a year for the past 10 years, but round-the-world walker Jean Beliveau knows he can still count on her support as he closes in on the finish of his epic journey.

After all, he still only has to walk to Hobart, across New Zealand and then across Canada from west to east.

He estimates it will only take him about another 18 months.

Mr Beliveau started the Australian leg of his walk in Darwin in October.

He had a rest day in Bundaberg yesterday but he will set out on his journey again today, pushing a trolley that contains his few supplies.
